- I. School Health Advisory Council (SHAC) update – Nurse Reyes
  - A. Parent wanting to have sex ed at the lower grades 3-5<sup>th</sup> having difficulties finding criteria. Already have 8-10<sup>th</sup> grade still need to have it this year. If you teach any type of sex ed need to have parent notification at least 14 days in advance and parents may opt out. Parents wanting school to discuss puberty in lower grades.
    - a. Proctor and gamble might be the best solution. There is a whole curriculum for 5<sup>th</sup> grade. Permission slips, basics, menstrual cycle.
    - b. “Big Decisions” 10 sections. Met with Mr. Alvarado and will meet during PLCs/activity periods. Mr. Alvarado is ready...week of February 21<sup>st</sup>. 10<sup>th</sup> grade tue/wed; 8<sup>th</sup> grade mon/fri?? Must be reviewed by SHAC committee
    - c. ESTEEM – provides books: \$500 for curriculum + \$85 for leader kits + \$4.50/student for workbooks + training (1-2 day training) Teachers (SS, Geography, Physics??) 45-90 minutes
    - d. Who’s going to teach this? Mrs. Reyes is offering to teach. Most are taught in a health class but none at any grade level at this time. Teacher could provide information to students but Nurse would come in to teach about contraceptives.
    - e. TEKS are required for hygiene - but do not go into specifics for puberty.
  - B. Co-chair needed and must be a parent. DOI. Most parents are busy and not able to make it. May have to postpone voting. Next meetings: March 8<sup>th</sup> and April 5<sup>th</sup>.
